Hospice & Palliative CareCenter (HPCC)
Grief Counseling Services (GCS)
offers up to 12 individual grief counseling sessions for those
who are caring for a loved one at the end of life,
as well as for those who are grieving a death-related loss.

There are no charges for these services, though
donations are sincerely appreciated.

Grief Counseling services are available to HPCC patients
and families, as well as anyone in the community.

Grief Counseling services are available for children
(beginning at age 6); for teens; and for adults.

Licensed, Board Certified, Registered Art Therapist on staff.

Camp Carousel, an annual bereavement retreat for children, teens, and
adults, is offered each summer in Winston-Salem on the HPCC campus.

Counselors are licensed, masters-degree professionals.
Interns and fellows are supervised by licensed counselors.
